We look forward to meeting with you and providing you with an overview of how your child is doing at preschool.

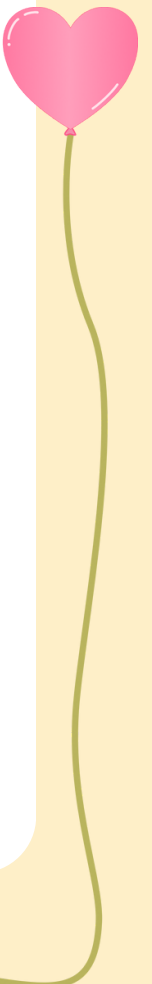
We will discuss how your child is during class time, meal time and play time.

Please note that the school will be closed on Monday November 3rd and on Monday November 24th.

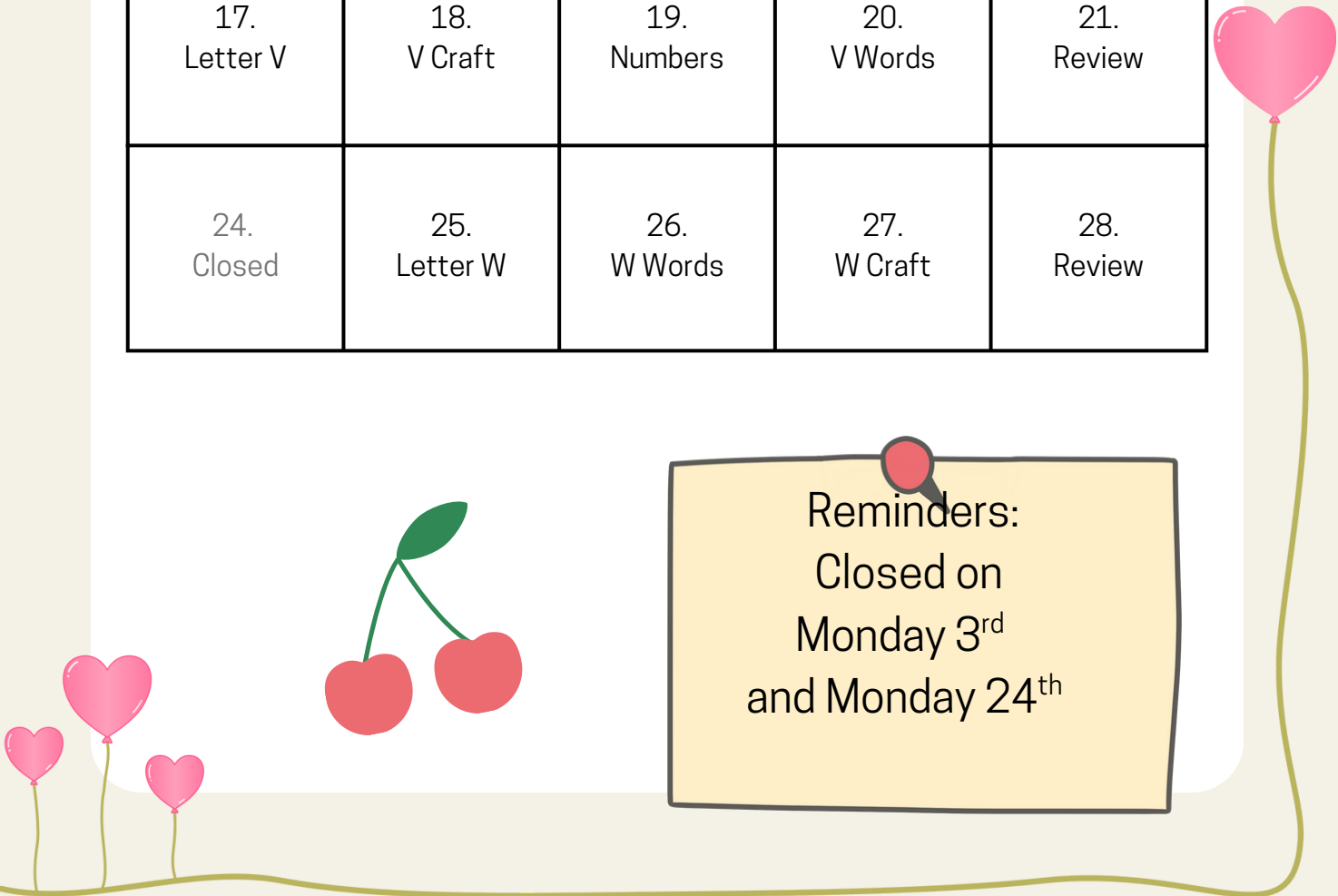

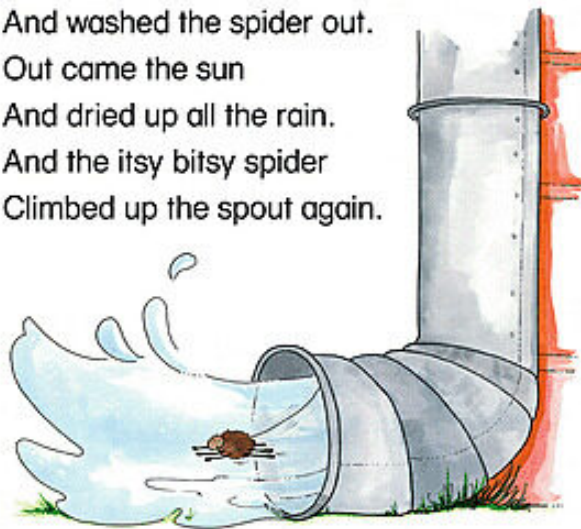
One, two, buckle my shoe
