



# APPLE CLASS 2026 Newsletter JUNE


Dear Parents,

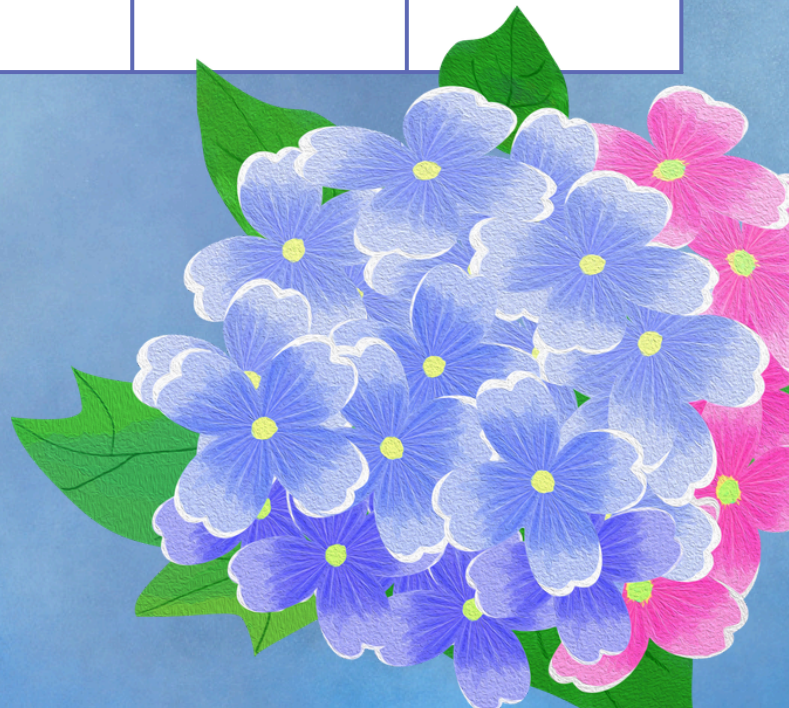




